Dear Parents,

If you have ever tried to maneuver a car through the drop off zones during the busy times at Forbes, then I'm sure that you'll agree that it can sometimes be a frustrating process. Although drop off and pick up times at school can be frustrating, much more important is the fact that our kids are put at risk when traffic rules are not followed.

I believe that we can fix this problem, keep our kids safe, and make drop off much less frustrating if we all follow just 4 simple rules:

- 1. If you are going to park your car, use the parking stalls.
- 2. Do not park in the loading and unloading zones.
- 3. Do not stop in the pull through zones.
- 4. Children must use the crosswalks.

This year, we have more buses then we have ever had before. For this reason, please do not park or drive in the BUS ONLY zone during 9-9:30 AM and 3-3:30 PM.

Please be patient and courteous as you drop off and pick up your children. Help us keep our kids safe.
