Ryan welcomed everyone to the new year of community council. It was decided to review the plan from last year and decide what would be implemented this year. The report is due Oct. 20<sup>th</sup>.

Our goals were to hire a home reading coordinator, provide Double Dose, provide STAR tutoring, provide aides in larger class sizes, provide a stipend for specialty teachers to attend collaboration, a stipend for 1<sup>st</sup> grade to do DRA testing before school, and provide teachers with Scholastic News. Each item needs to have a measurement tool to show improvement in the school.

We will hold four meetings during the year: September, November, January and March. In April we will hold a meeting to discuss the plan for the following year. We need to implement our current plan. Some ideas for next year were discussed; possible teacher grants for science, mounting of projectors.
