Students and staff collaborate so that everyone benefits from the whole team effort. This synergy helps us put first things first!



School Community Council

The Utah Legislature requires all schools to establish a School Community Council (SCC) to provide input, receive feedback, and have stewardship over a number of critical school duties. Specifically, the SCC responsibilities include: creating a school improvement plan, managing the school Trust Land monies (approximately \$65,000 a year for a school of our size), assisting with professional development, analyzing school data, assessing academic needs, purchasing resources, and implementing a reading achievement plan.



2016-2017 Trust Land Expenditures








Current Student Demographics
