Keys to Success

- 1. **Perception is reality.** Try not to be too offended or defensive about people's perceptions. Try to change the perception.
- 2. **Race to the parents**. If there is a problem at school, communicate the truth to parents before the child gets home.



- 3. **No surprises.** Parents should not be surprised by bad behavior at SEP's or by a poor grade with a report card.
- 4. **Be nurturing.** Treat the students the way you would wan your child or grandchild treated.
