- In the category of proficiency Westfield scored 276/300
- In the category of growth, Westfield scored 191/300

Organize Council

We chose and voted on a new council chair and co-chair Carla Merrill was nominated, seconded and selected as the council chair Misha Peay was nominated, seconded and selected as the council co-chair

School Trust Lands Money

Total budget \$46, 637

- Mrs. Thomas told us that the school district will now cover the salary of our computer specialty teacher; this frees up \$26,000 originally marked to pay for that salary
- Discussion of STARS reading program and recommendation by Mrs. Thomas and Mrs. Alldredge to continue funding this program; 15 students can participate
- Discussion of technology funding; approximately \$8000 would be needed to provide a cart and 30 tablets
- Discussion of using the SCC money to help the PTA pay for a 2nd new computer lab
- Proposal to spend \$3-5,000 to pay STARS reading aides
- Proposal from Mrs. Thomas to use \$3400 to pay for double dosing; this benefits all grades and could help growth scores
- Proposal by Mrs. Thomas to use \$8253 for a professional development seminar (Pyramid Response to Intervention) taught by Mike Mattos in Las Vegas; she

believes this seminar can train teachers to collaborate more effectively and impact our school growth scores

- Task given to Mrs. Thomas to find how many teachers can attend Mike Mattos conference at BYU
- Task given to all to come up with proposals on how we can use our budget to meet the needs of the school population
