

Nov. 9, 2015 SCC Minutes

3:40 meeting opened. There were no changes to previous months minutes.

- Jeremy is not eligible to serve as Vice Chair. Jacquie was nominated by Jeremy, Carrie seconded, all voted in favor.
- Jeremy distributed a chart detailing the usage of funds allocated towards technology. Chart is attached below, at the end of the minutes.
- Report on the aide training by teachers:

Each grade got a half day sub to cover the class/es of the teachers that were to train the aides. Most grades just had one or a few teachers train the aide. First grade felt like it was useful. They were able to go in depth and the aide was able to ask questions. 4th trained aide on chromebooks and ways to go over things to help students and addressed questions from the aide. 6th grade felt it was productive to be able to meet with the aide.

Further suggestios:

It was suggested that perhaps in collaboration each week the team could go over the aide time schedule and see how to best utilize the aide for the week.

During Professional development training at the beginning of the year, have a teacher present how to most effectively use the aides, share ideas, ect.

- Digital Citizenship:

SCC needs to decide if our technology plan is adequate, how we teach good digital citizenship to the students and how to educate parents.

Jeremy made a motion that we organize a committee to take care of this and Stephanie seconded. Motion passed.

Parent education- Jacquie suggested having the computer classes make video's we can post online for parents to look at. All were in favor.

- Changes to the way the school accounts are able to be redistributed. General plan for school-the accounts have to match for each subgrouping . Jeremy allocated the extra money for this years plan into the aide accounts.

Jeremy allocated the extra aide times among all the grades. The chrome books/iPad's need to be purchased, we have about \$22,000 to spend on that. The tech committee is meeting on 11/12 to figure out the purchasing of this years technology.

- First grade team wrote a letter to ask for more aide time for their team.

First grade compared to K,2,3 have a large amount of students who are not meeting the standards and the first grade team is very worried about the students falling behind.

Carrie is also needing more aide time in resource.

Jeremy is going to ask the CTL's if there is any aide time they can give up to the 1st grade and resource as well as re-evaluating budget.

Aides work for 29 weeks, each grade get 2.30 hours a day/4 days a week

- School safety-

There was some concern after an adult was handing out balloons and flyers on school grounds. School safety is a top priority and everyone has a strong desire to keep all children safe. This issue needs to be done on a district level and we would be in favor of creating a no soliciting zone. The school can ask them to leave if they are on school property but not if they are on public property ie. Sidewalks. The school community council supports a city ordinance that supports a non soliciting zone. Jeremy will contact the Mayor and let them know we support a no soliciting zone.

- Typing-

The SCC is concerned about the typing skills of the students are Cedar Ridge.
